

01 TOWN HALL
The building, formerly a castle and court's residence, was transformed into a town hall from 1858 to 1869 by the architect Louis Dubouché. The hall has retained only two towers of the 16th century. The polygonal keep and the 16th tower of the 16th century where Marguerite d'Angoulême was born in 1547.

02 "NATCHA AND THE PETIT BOUT D'CHOU"
François MAILLET (in memory of his friend and his friend Natcha) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

03 "THE BLACK BARON"
GOT & PÉLÉRIEN (in memory of his friend and his friend Got) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

04 THE BUST OF HERGE
This bronze bust is the work of the Chinese sculptor Feng CHANG. It is a homage to the Belgian cartoonist friend HERGE, known as Tintin.

05 GASTON & PRUNELLE FRANQUIN
At the corner of the Herge and Franquin Marriage.

06 ST. MARTIAL CHURCH
The imposing bell tower, south of the church built in the 11th century by the count of Angoulême, was destroyed in 1800. At the location, there was once a large Romanesque church surrounded by its cemetery.

07 "VOYAGE AU TRAVERS DES IMAGES"
Philippe BRULLET (in memory of his friend and his friend Philippe) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

08 THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SOCIETY
This museum, labeled "Musée de France", houses regional collections to discover the regional history of Angoulême, with its most famous characters: Aristide Briand, Albert Einstein, and Jean-Louis Trintignant.

09 "THE WORLD OF RENE GOSCINNY"
MOON & CÉLÉSTE (in memory of his friend and his friend Moon) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

10 "AVEC LES TEMPS"
FRANÇOIS SCHIEN (in memory of his friend and his friend François) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

11 "LES PIEDS NICKELÉS"
PELLÉ (in memory of his friend and his friend Pellé) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

12 "THE GIRL OF THE MARSHES"
MAGUIER (in memory of his friend and his friend Maguière) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

13 LES HALLES
Built by the architect Edouard BIGNON and the engineer JOHANNES POMMER, the hall replaced the 16th century hall built in 1547. The beautiful architecture is directly inspired by the architecture of the 16th century, by the architect Louis Dubouché.

14 "THE COSMOS OF RENÉ GOSCINNY"
MOON & CÉLÉSTE (in memory of his friend and his friend Moon) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

15 "TITIF"
ZEP (in memory of his friend and his friend Zep) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

16 ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH
Located in the heart of Angoulême, St. Andrew's is one of the oldest churches in the city, along with St. Julien and St. Catherine's.

17 "MEMORIES OF THE 20th SKY"
YVARE (in memory of his friend and his friend Yvare) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

18 THE COURTHOUSE / PLACE LOUVEL
Built in 1825 by the architect Paul BOULE, it is a neo-classical building in the style of the Palais de Justice in Paris. It was built on the site of the former courtyard, where the garden has been replaced by a public square, adjacent with a 19th century fountain.

19 "EMERGENCY EXIT REALITY"
Nico ANDRÉ (in memory of his friend and his friend Nico) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

20 MINING SQUARE
The square was built in the 19th century with a fountain, a monument to the miners, and a clock tower. It is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

21 THE RAMPARTS
The city was protected by a wall, which was destroyed in 1800. The ramparts were built in the 16th century, by the architect Louis Dubouché.

22 PLACE BEAULIEU
The layout of the square, on a 19th-century promenade, corresponds to the urban development under the reign of Louis XVIII, by the architect Louis Dubouché.

23 LE JARDIN VERT (GREEN CORRIDOR)
Created in 1860, this park of approximately 1 hectare, designed by the architect Louis Dubouché, is a beautiful example of 19th-century urban development.

24 BARDINE MANSION
Built by the architect Louis Dubouché, the mansion is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture. It was built on the site of the former courtyard, where the garden has been replaced by a public square, adjacent with a 19th century fountain.

25 CHAPEL OF THE CORDIERS
At the beginning of the 13th century, two medieval cordeliers settled in Angoulême. The chapel was built in 1250, by the architect Louis Dubouché. It is a beautiful example of 13th-century architecture.

26 ST. PETER'S CATHEDRAL
Angoulême has the distinction of having a Romanesque cathedral and not a Gothic one like many other cities in France. The high sculpted facade is the centerpiece of the cathedral. Several major themes are represented: the Annunciation, the Adoration of Christ and the Last Judgment. The architect Paul ABRIOT (in memory of his friend and his friend Paul) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

27 ANGOULÊME MUSEUM
Installed since 1900 in the former episcopal palace, the work of architect Paul ABRIOT (in memory of his friend and his friend Paul) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

28 CARNOT STATUE
Sadi CARNOT, President of the Republic, born in Limoges in 1801, was assassinated in Lyon by CASERIO, on June 24, 1858. It was Louis TRÉL (in memory of his friend and his friend Louis) who was entrusted with the creation of this commemorative statue, executed by CAROTI. It was surrounded by allegories of Liberty and of Working France. It is installed on a hydraulic bridge, New York Square. It was inaugurated in 1857.

29 MUNICIPAL THEATER NATIONAL STAGE
It was built between 1898 and 1910 by the architect Auguste PERRET (in memory of his friend and his friend Auguste) and Charles BOURGEOIS (in memory of his friend and his friend Charles). The theater is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

30 "BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE THEATER"
DUJOY & BERGAMINI (in memory of his friend and his friend Dujoy) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

31 PREFECTURE
This building, which gave its name to the district, was erected in 1827 by the architect Paul ABRIOT (in memory of his friend and his friend Paul). It is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

32 D'ROUX
This doctor from Combrailles, devoted his life to the study of diseases, and was elected to the Académie des Sciences in 1800. He was a member of the Académie des Sciences, and was elected to the Académie des Sciences in 1800.

33 CHURCH OF OBEZINE
Its construction began in 1806 on the site of an 18th-century building, and ended with the installation of the organ in 1810. It is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

34 STATUE OF MARGUERITE OF VALOIS
This stone statue was made in 1871 by the sculptor Joseph-François BAUDOUIN DE LA ROCHE-CHATELAIN (in memory of his friend and his friend Joseph-François). It is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

35 "BLACK ET MORTIMER"
André BILLET (in memory of his friend and his friend André) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

36 "THE ARCHIVIST"
FRANÇOIS SCHIEN (in memory of his friend and his friend François) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

37 "THE OBELISK AND THE MENIR"
This comic strip obelisk, created by René Goscinny, is a beautiful example of 19th-century architecture.

38 "THE EXTRAORDINARY GARDENS"
Renée GOSCINNY (in memory of his friend and his friend Renée) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

39 "SALES MOCHES"
BERNARD COBERHAN (in memory of his friend and his friend Bernard) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

40 "NEW YORK ON CHARENTE"
Nicolas DE CROCY (in memory of his friend and his friend Nicolas) has the air, he has been traveling around the world with courage and spirit since 1970, accompanied by his dog, Natcha.

41 "EST RIMA ANCHÉ EN SA CITY"

42 "A SATURDAY IN MALANGOS"

43 "LUCKY LUKE, THE DALTONS AND 'L'ÉVALUÉ JUMPER'"

44 "SALES MOCHES"

45 INTERNATIONAL CITY OF COMICS AND IMAGE DISTRICT TOUR


